Dear Utopia Park Resident,

With the phased closure of Utopia Park, MIU is taking proactive steps to assist residents who may need support with housing resources. We have partnered with Milestones, an organization that serves individuals aged 60 and older.

Representatives from Milestones will be onsite to meet individually with residents who would like assistance exploring available housing options and related support services.

We have scheduled two informational sessions. To help begin the application process, please bring the following:

Required Identification

- Social Security card
- Driver's license or valid state-issued ID

Financial Documentation

- Three (3) months of bank statements (checking and/or savings)
- Verification of income (SSI, SSDI, stipends, or any other monthly income)

Asset Information

- Please be prepared to list any assets on the application, including:
- Vehicle(s)
- Property
- Life insurance policies

Veteran Status

- If you receive income from the VA, documentation of that income will need to be included.

Medicaid / SNAP Applicants

- If you are applying for Medicaid or SNAP, please bring **two (2) copies** of all required verification documents so they can be included in each application packet.

Once Milestones receives your completed application, they will begin assisting you in identifying available housing options.

Please bring any questions you may have, along with the required documents listed above.

We understand that this is a significant transition, and we are committed to supporting you throughout this process.
